Dear Hamilton County Board of Commissioners,

I am writing to update you about the Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati's progress on the Daly Road Sewer Replacement Project. This project involves replacing approximately 8,000 feet of sewer pipe in your neighborhood, near Daly Road between Compton Road and the Ronald Reagan Highway. The existing sanitary sewer is very old and in poor condition and cannot handle the flow properly, particularly during wet weather.

Since our last letter in January 2011, we have completed all of the surveying, design, and engineering work, and we have hired a construction contractor. Vegetative clearing will begin in January 2015, east of the intersection of Compton and Daly Roads, and will run mostly parallel to Brentwood Creek, ending at Daly Road north of Pinehollow Lane. (See map on the enclosed project fact sheet.) The project is expected to take about 18 months to complete.

MSD's contractor, Brackney Construction, generally will work Monday through Thursday between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. Depending on weather, it may be necessary to work some Fridays or on an occasional weekend. Every effort will be made to minimize disturbances during construction, but dust, dirt, noise, and vibrations should be expected. Heavy equipment will be present at all times. Water and sewer service will be maintained throughout the project. If temporary service interruptions are needed when the new line is put into service, you will receive advance notification. MSD's construction management team will monitor the quality and progress of the work and will require the contractor to maintain an orderly work site.

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# DALY ROAD SEWER REPLACEMENT 2015-2016

## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati (MSD) will be replacing approximately 8,000 linear feet of existing sewer pipe in your neighborhood near Daly Road between Compton Road and the Ronald Reagan Highway.


The existing sanitary sewer needs replaced because of its age, size, and poor condition. It cannot be used as-is to handle the current flow load. The new sewer will be larger in diameter (30 inches) to provide the proper capacity.

The Daly Road Sewer Replacement Project is just one of MSD's Project Groundwork initiatives, which are designed to make our communities cleaner, healthier, and more economically sustainable.

## SCHEDULE

Sewer work is expected to begin January 2015 and last until summer 2016. Construction activities generally will take place between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m., Monday through Friday. Weekend work may be needed at times.

Final restoration of areas disturbed during construction will begin after sewer installation is complete. These restoration activities are expected to be completed in summer 2016.

# DALY ROAD SEWER REPLACEMENT

## TEMPORARY INCONVENIENCES

Access to homes and businesses will be maintained but may be difficult at times. Please allow extra time when traveling on impacted streets.

Temporary disruption of utility services (e.g., telephone or cable TV) is possible, but we will make every effort to minimize the duration of service disruptions if they occur.

Other temporary inconveniences include:

- Clearing of trees and brush along construction limits
- Heavy construction equipment and vehicles working within the construction limits and easements
- Possible lane/road closures
- Noise, dirt and vibrations

- Concrete barricades, fencing and trench plates
- Staging of construction equipment and materials at various locations.

## SAFETY

- An on-site inspector will be present during working hours.
- Open trenches will be plated during non-working hours, and bore pits will be surrounded by fencing at all times.
- Children and pets are often curious about construction work. Please keep them away from machinery, trenches, and pits at all times.
- If you see a potentially unsafe situation or fencing that requires repair, please contact MSD Customer Service immediately at (513) 557-3594.
- If you become aware of a public safety hazard, please call 911 immediately.
