Winton Road Improvement HAM-CR 239-5.39 (ODOT PID 98772) Public Meeting – Feb. 4th 2016

WELCOME

The Ohio Dept. of Transportation (ODOT) and Hamilton Co. Engineer's Office (HCEO) are pleased to hold a public meeting for the improvement of Winton Road between Fleming Road and Sarbrook Road. This meeting will provide a platform by which all interested persons may have an opportunity to review current plans, and provide input into the decision making process. This project is designed to provide safer roadway conditions for the traveling public through this stretch of Winton Road.

This handout and the materials that have been developed to summarize the proposed project are on display to present the proposed project currently under consideration. Project study team representatives are available at the meeting to answer your questions and take comments.

PURPOSE OF MEETING

The purpose of the Public Involvement Meeting is to seek comments on the recent studies pertaining to the proposed roadway improvement and assist in determining areas of concern. The proposed improvement would add a lane in the center of the road. This lane would be a two-way-left-turn lane from Fleming Road to Sarbrook Road.

The addition of the two-way-left-turn lane would widen the roadway about the center of Winton Road for a length of approximately 2,600ft.

PROBLEM IDENTIFICATION

Winton Road is classified as an Urban Minor Arterial. The Average Daily Traffic (ADT) for this section of Winton Road is 27,500 vehicles per day (VPD). Crash rates in this section of Winton Road are approximately 3 times the state average for similar roadways. Crash rates will continue to be 3 times the state average if no improvements are made.

PURPOSE AND NEED FOR THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT

The purpose of the proposed action is to improve the traffic flow, reduce congestion, and improve vehicle and pedestrian access to the facilities within this section of Winton Road. The purpose includes rehabilitation of existing pavement including substantial full depth and partial depth repairs to the existing pavement, repair of curb, storm sewer inlets and widen sidewalks.

The proposed action is needed to address crashes within the project area and to address the deteriorating roadway surface. Most recent crash analysis for this section of Winton Road (2009-2011) demonstrates that nearly 50% of all accidents were rear-end in nature, indicating crashes related to left-turn movements. These crashes occurred at or near the intersections with Millbrook Drive, the Powell Crosley Jr. YMCA drive and St. Bartholomew Church drive.
